Race Structure

- 3-hour race. One day free testing (Friday), two days competition (Saturday and Sunday).
Total track time: 8h 35m

Driver Requirements

- Two or three drivers per car
- Five compulsory pit stops, 6 stints (average 30 minutes)
- Open to drivers with any National or International licence

Costs

- Entry fee: EUR 3,900 per car (including garage)
- Fuel: 98-octane EUR 2.90/litre (approx.)
- Tyres: Michelin H2 (new Michelin version for 2025)



Benefits for the teams

- Compete to win on an equal playing field with no GT3 cars.
- Exceptional financial support for teams interested in racing in the UAE (Abu Dhabi and Dubai) during the next winter season (total value up to EUR 12,000 each team).
- Enjoy a world-class venue at Portimao's circuit.
